Oceanside Minor Hockey Back to Play Protocols

- **Entry to Facility for purpose of Conditioning Sessions and Competitive Try Outs:**

As directed by the Public Health Authority and ViaSport, masks are now **mandatory** until further notice in all areas of the arena facility except for the field of play.

All players will enter through the main doors of the arena and go to their assigned dressing room that will be noted on the board that is located just outside of the lobby office.

Spectators are permitted in the arena stands providing numbers stay below the capacity indicated in the next section. Please do not dwell in the lobby area of the facility.

During tryouts, please do not leave children unattended in the lobby area of the facility.

- ❖ Please remember that the OMHA volunteers are devoted to ensuring that your players are kept safe while attending their sessions. Anyone who has disputes, abuses rules, or verbally expresses their negative opinions regarding our association protocols, will be asked to leave immediately. Further consequences could occur if non-compliance of the protocols continue.

- **Capacity:**

- Howie Meeker Rink: 500 persons max. which includes participants and spectators but excluding event staff.
- Victor Kraatz Rink: 100 persons max. which includes participants and spectators but excluding event staff.
- Lobby: 50 persons max.

- **Change Rooms:**

Change room capacities have returned to "normal numbers". Masks are mandatory for all members when in the change rooms.

Players need to put all their belongings in their hockey bags and kept neatly under the benches. Please ensure that water bottles are not shared, and clearly labelled with your player's name.

* ***SPITTING*** will not be tolerated. Anyone caught spitting anywhere in the facility will receive a serious consequence! This includes areas such as the ice, hallways, bench and changerooms.

- **Exiting Building:**

Once your player's session is completed, all participants are asked to leave within 15 minutes in order to give facility staff enough time for sanitizing change rooms between sessions.
